Thank you for taking the time to fill out this application, we want to ensure that all our animals find their forever homes and we appreciate your patience during the adoption process. Please understand that animals that come into our care can come from unknown origin and background. Some animals have been abused, neglected or have been in foster care for some time. We cannot guarantee that the animal's behavior will not change once in your care. EARS will try to gather as much information as possible. The animal's behavior and traits are based through observation only. Age, breed and health are only based on the history that the previous owners or rescue have supplied with the rescued animal. If there is something noticeable or if the vet finds something on a vet check EARS will provide funds as long as they are in our care. EARS will not knowingly adopt out a sick animal or one with extremely severe behavioral issues without first providing full disclosure about the animal and ensuring that the animal goes to an appropriate home with the experience and resources to care for such an animal. Adopting an animal is a serious commitment. Cats and Dogs can live 10+ years and we would like to make all adoptive applicants are aware of and willing and able to accept the physical, emotional, and financial responsibilities of pet ownership for the life of the animal.

Please INITIAL the following:

_____ I understand that E.A.R.S. does their best to find the most compatible foster home for each animal in care. In the event that I realize that my home is not a good fit, or home circumstances have changed, I agree to give E.A.R.S. a minimum of 2 weeks' notice in non-emergency situation in order to find a new placement for the animal in question.

_____ I agree to foster this animal until it is ready for adoption i.e. spayed/neutered, vaccinated, and the EARS adoption committee agrees upon the fact that said animal is ready to be adopted into my guardianship.

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_____ I understand that until an official adoption takes place, E.A.R.S. bears sole guardianship to said animal and must be notified of any lifestyle changes or decisions regarding the animal.

_____ I will provide my pet with a nurturing, safe, and loving environment with nutritious food in sufficient quantities to maintain proper health, plenty of fresh water, adequate space to be active, and proper shelter from the elements at all times.

_____ I will treat my animal with respect, love and dignity at all times.

_____ I will correct inappropriate behavior in a firm but gentle manner.

_____ I will provide regular veterinary care.

_____ I will under no circumstances abandon this animal.

_____ I do not intend to sell this animal.

_____ If, for any reason I am unable to keep my adopted animal and I find a new home for the animal, I agree to inform EARS of the change of ownership. If I cannot find another loving home for the animal, I agree to surrender the animal back to E.A.R.S.

_____ I agree to be solely responsible for any damage caused to any person, animal or property. I hereby waive Edson Animal Rescue Society and its representatives of responsibility unless found to be negligent.

_____ I agree to accept responsibility for making timely veterinary appointments for this animal when needed (i.e. for vaccinations and spay/neuter) as well as transporting to and from the vet clinic, and informing E.A.R.S. when I have made appointments while this animal is still in E.A.R.S. care.
